ECONOMIC PERFORMANCE

000 101 In 2020, the net sales of MVM Group amounted to HUF 1,835.1 **billion**, while the investments of MVM Group amounted to HUF 132.6 billion. In 2020, the total EBITDA of the Group was HUF 163.5 billion.



MVM Paks Nuclear Power Plant Ltd. closed 2020 with a 16,055 GWh total electricity output.



The installed electrical capacity of our power plants increased by more than 33% to **4,051** M_{we} in 2020 compared to 2019, and our installed thermal capacity is 9,001 MW_{th}.



With its **4.2 million** customers, MVM Group is the largest energy provider of Hungary.



Thanks to the photovoltaic power plant investments, the electric capacity of the solar parks increased by more than 56% from 2019 to 2020, reaching **166 M**_{we}. Thus, the electricity generated by solar energy meets the annual electricity demand of more than **150,000** people.



In 2020, MVM Group generated 20,842 GWh of electrical and 3,937 TJ of heat energy.

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION



Nearly 300 employees of the MVM Group planted 12,000 trees in the Kiskunság National Park.



The electric vehicle charging network of MVM Mobiliti Ltd. provided **998,296 kWh** of energy for charging, and a total of **107,220** charges were successfully carried out by our customers.



The solar panels of the solar parks established by MVM Green Generation Ltd. have filters that can reduce polar light pollution.



The electrical and thermal energy generated by MVM Group is nearly 78% carbon neutral.

The amount of MVM Group's CO₂ savings is almost 6 million tonnes, regarding carbon free energy sources.
